A. Faculty, Staff and Students

2. The costs of secretarial and clerical personnel, technician and other scientific support personnel will be borne by the person concerned or the employer of such personnel.

B. Space and Facilities

1. Working Space and infrastructure required for the project will be provided by the respective institutions.
2. Joint use of each other's equipment and facilities as long as such cooperative use does not disrupt the normal programs of either party.



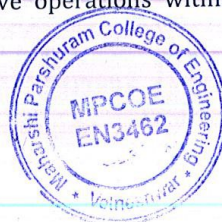

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

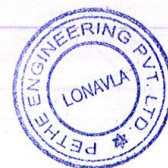

CLAU**S**E 4 VALIDITY


